

Our pipeline of undergraduate health majors had decreased significantly prior to the pandemic




- Undergraduate health enrollments declined by almost 7,000 students, or 41%, by AY 20.
- Graduate-level enrollments increased by 41%, or 2,696, for the same period.
- While upskilling is good, this contributes to a large deficit in staffing of entry- to mid-level healthcare professions.






Add healthcare organizations across kentucky have committed their money, staff, time and equipment to assist in CPE's healthcare workforce initiatives.
